

Governance Policy of ARA (Action for Rural Advancement)

Action for Rural Advancement (ARA) is a fully registered and legally compliant non-governmental organization in Bangladesh. The organization maintains strict adherence to national laws and regulations, ensuring transparency and accountability in all institutional operations.

Governance:

ARA is governed by a General Body and an Executive Committee (EC). The Executive Committee is responsible for policy-making and strategic direction, while the management team, led by the Executive Director, ensures smooth implementation of programs at the grassroots level. Regular audits and Annual General Meetings (AGM) are conducted to ensure strong governance.

General Committee:

The highest decision-making body composed of 21 experienced volunteer members responsible for policy formulation and strategic direction.

Executive Committee:

A 7-member committee elected for a two-year term. The Executive Director serves as Member Secretary. It implements policies and holds quarterly meetings.

Advisory Committee:

A 3-member committee providing expert guidance, strategic advice, and support for organizational development and decision-making.
